

FOSTER FAMILIES NEEDED


The Tennessee Baptist Children's Homes operates three family style campuses for children in our state. They also facilitate foster care through the George Shinn Foster Care Program. The TBCH is currently in need of more foster families. Presently, they have 68 foster homes that are caring for 93 children in our state. In East Tennessee there are 29 homes caring for 44 children. They would love to be able to serve more children but that can only be done if more families are willing to become foster parents. The TBCH only recruits evangelical families to foster. 
VBS 2026

ANNUAL CHURCH PROFILE


In July every church clerk should have received their packet of information in the mail to complete their church's Annual Church Profile.










RA CAMPOREE


