


there will be an opportunity to give. If you would like to attend you can RSVP at hawkinstn@isaiah117-house.com.

Along with meeting practical needs of the women that visit the Center, I also want to provide opportunities for them to build community in a church setting. Currently, there are three weekly meetings that clients of the Pregnancy Center are invited to, in addition to a regular church service. Outside the Walls meets every Wednesday at the Shepard's Center. Several families from the Center come regularly. It is a family atmosphere, and children are welcome. The second is a ministry at East Rogersville Baptist Church called Redeemed by Grace. This is a recovery ministry that helps women and men find freedom in Christ through Bible study. Usually a handful of Pregnancy Center clients participate. We meet every Sunday at 5:00 pm, with a meal, worship, and small groups by gender. Lastly, there is a meeting every Friday at Henards Chapel Baptist Church called Embrace Grace. This group is for single moms who are pregnant or have a baby less than 6 months of age. All of these groups provide community and practical support for clients of the Pregnancy Center. They are different but at the same time, similarly focused on the gospel and discipleship of men, women, and children.

In January the Tennessee Baptist Mission Board hosted their annual Bivocational Ministers and Wives Retreat in Gatlinburg. 
