HVBA Office Floors

They believe that the hardwood will last longer than if it were recarpeted. At the May Executive Board meeting the Finance Committee

The Trustees have purchased the hardwood and delivered it to the HVBA office. The **HVBA** Disaster Relief/Baptist Builders Team plan to install the hardwood floors the week of July 12th. Our office will be closed during that week to allow them to install the floors.


